CONTEXT DIAGRAM

















DESIGN PRINCIPLES

» Minimise impact on views from residential area by minimising frontage, keep single storey elements on the Scenic Drive side and the Hall (courts) furthest away from the road.

- » Create simple and useful connections to the existing landscapes and buildings.
- » Establish a youth graphic/public art wall which creates the centre's identity and entrance to the new sports hub building.
- » Create a plan around a central foyer/kitchen/changeroom hub with direct access to all sports and meeting related rooms.
- » Create a building which embraces a context and a sense of place for all existing elements.
- » Ensure building finished floor level provides protection against flooding (Note: A full survey of the site is required).
- » Establish a new crossover (ramped down) to a new parking facility of 72 bays which links back to the existing crossover and
- » Create building spaces which are primarily glazed to the north and south and/or into the beautiful forest environment of the existing site.
