

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entries must be works of non-fiction.
2. Entries must be the original work of the entrant. Use of work by other authors must be acknowledged and sources properly referenced.
3. The topic(s) must be relevant to the history and development of the Wanneroo region
4. Only one entry is allowed per person.
5. Submissions will be added to the Collection in the Community History Centre. The Centre retains the right to use an entry as it chooses, with due acknowledgement to the author.
6. The decision of the judges will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
7. The City of Wanneroo reserves the right not to present an award if the entries do not justify one.
8. The limits on the length of entries are 5,000 words for Original Research and 4000 words for Personal Memoirs/Migrant Stories.
9. Submit in A4 format, preferably typed with a good margin. Twelve point font and 1.5 spacing preferred.
10. Two copies required. One hard copy and if possible, one electronic copy.
11. Entries, including the application form, must reach the Community History Centre, Wanneroo Library and Cultural Centre, Locked Bag 1, Wanneroo WA 6946, by 4 pm on Friday 24 April 2015.

Alternately, by hand to the Community History Centre, Ground Floor, Wanneroo Library and Cultural Centre, 3 Rocca Way, Wanneroo.

THE AWARD

The Community History Award aims to encourage original research into the history and heritage of the City of Wanneroo, an area which stretches from Two Rocks in the north to Girrawheen in the south. This research will be added to the collection in the Wanneroo Regional Museum's Community History Centre where it can be shared with the community.

Entries can focus on any aspect of Wanneroo history such as a historic building, pioneer family or individual biography, history of an organisation, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander stories and memories of a particular decade or event.

There are two prize categories:

Original Research

1st Prize \$500 2nd Prize \$150

FORMAT

Unpublished essay with or without illustrative material. (Maximum 5,000 words).

Personal Memoirs/Migrant Stories

1st Prize \$500 2nd Prize \$150

FORMAT

1. Unpublished memoir with or without illustrative material (Maximum 4,000 words)
2. Audio or audio-visual material with or without support material. Audio format preferably as a digital wav file on CD. Consent form essential and transcript if possible.
