On Friday, 19 April the City hosted a function of appreciation for their efforts throughout the past year and it was thoroughly deserved. Previously, I have called all our volunteers "the salt of the earth" and I mean it.

I appreciate and admire everyone who gives their own time to serve others and we could not achieve all the work we do as a City without our volunteers. Their contribution throughout a particularly busy year speaks volumes about the City of Wanneroo and that special spirit of community, even family, this City prides itself on.

I thank them and their families who support them in their efforts to help others.

**Our SES Volunteers** - 65 in all, assist in emergency search and rescue for natural disasters.

**Two Rocks Volunteer Marine Rescue Group** - with more than 50 volunteers, save peoples' lives every week and recently rescued people in a boat 28 miles offshore.

**Yanchep Fire and Rescue** - with 22 volunteers, responds to fires and traffic crashes and shows fantastic community spirit by conducting the

"Santa Run" on Christmas Eve, giving out lollies to local kids.

**Quinns Mindarie Surf Lifesaving Club** - with 208 members and more than 100 active junior members, has clocked up 3,500 hours of patrols this season.

**Yanchep Surf Lifesaving Club** - with only six volunteers, patrols the Lagoon and was involved in the dramatic rescue of 12 abalone hunters in wild seas last November.

**Driver Reviver team** - works to save lives on our roads. I thank Councillors Rudi Steffens, Dot Newton, Norm Hewer and volunteers Bill Street, Vern Andrews and Roy Kerr. Over 14 years, 10,317 motorists have stopped at the Driver Reviver caravan.

To all our volunteers, thank you all so much for your passion and for selflessly giving your time and talents to our City.

## GREYGUM PLACE AND BULWARRA WAY, QUINNS ROCKS

Works to upgrade the stormwater drainage system in Greygum Place, Bulwarra Way and Tapping Way, Quinns Rocks to prevent flooding of properties at the low point of the drainage catchment are progressing well. This \$500K project is 60% complete overall with drainage and reinstatement complete in Balwarra Way and almost completed in Tapping Way. Drainage work at the intersection of Greygum Crescent and Balwarra Way is expected to be completed during May 2013.
