Hello, I am Dot Newton one of your Central Ward Councillors, representing the residents and businesses in the suburbs of Tapping, Ashby, Mariginiup, Jandabup, Sinagra, Pearsall, Hocking, Wanneroo, Wangara and a part of Woodvale.

The Central Ward has everything but the beach; we have beautiful bushland, the showgrounds, established parks, lake systems, market gardens, and an ever growing and diverse residential area. Also located within the ward, is the major employment hub of Wangara.

Our road network has recently undergone major improvements including Pinjar Road and Ocean Reef Road, and works are currently underway for Lenore Road which should ease congestion during peak periods.

It is pleasing to see that Pearsall has its new primary school and shopping centre, and that the Hocking shopping centre should soon be underway. Council is also reviewing concept plans for the community building.

Everyone who has been down to the Opportunity Playspace at Rotary Park, Scenic Drive would agree that this facility is second to none, and how pleasing to see a playground that is so inclusive of families with disabilities. It is always great to see

families out enjoying our playgrounds and sporting facilities.

Our Town Centre is evolving and located next door to our Library and Cultural Centre on Dundobar Road, the GP Super Clinic is currently under construction. The shopping centre is now at capacity and there is hope that stage two will commence before too long.

If you haven't paid a visit to our Museum you have missed an absolute treat, as our Heritage Services Team has ensured that your experience will be both informative and enjoyable. Many new residents may also not be aware of our great swimming pool, gym and the many extras housed at Aquamotion on Civic Drive.
