The countdown is on to registering your cat

Is your loveable fur ball registered with the City of Wanneroo?

The Cat Act 2011 was passed by the West Australian Parliament in November 2011, so what does this mean for your feline friends?

From 1 November 2013, all cats over six months of age are required to be:

- Registered with a local government
- Sterilised (unless used for breeding by a registered breeder)
- » Microchipped so they can be returned to their owners if lost, stolen or straying from their owner's property.

Whilst owners are not required to sterilise or microchip their cats until 1 November 2013, the City of Wanneroo encourages responsible cat ownership and recommends that cat owners sterilise and microchip their cats before the due date.
