Sprout Hub Alkimos Beach – The perfect space for entrepreneurs and small business to connect, learn and earn

What is Sprout Hub Alkimos Beach?

Sprout Hub is a portable community hub with a cafe, co-working space, event space, digital community portal, social impact evaluation and community led charitable fund. The first Sprout Hub in Australia is being piloted in Alkimos Beach in the City of Wanneroo. This project has been delivering community activation since June 2014, when only six houses were occupied!



What is the vision of Sprout Hub?

Sprout Hub has set out to create an affordable way to deliver early stage community infrastructure and to pre-emptively address the long term issue of social isolation in the suburbs. Sprout Ventures and their partners had high aspirations for Alkimos Beach with the vision that it would be a vibrant community with a thriving local economy and healthy happy residents. Together they have provided Alkimos Beach residents with the tools they need to grow a socially sustainable and thriving neighbourhood.

What can Sprout Hub offer you as a business owner?

Sprout Hub Alkimos Beach provides co-working desks, meeting space, venue hire services, workshop facilities, free Wi-Fi and a small coffee kiosk, to support the needs of small and home based business establishing in the emerging Alkimos Beach community ahead of permanent commercial space becoming available. Sprout Hub is delivered via a three year partnership between Lend Lease, LandCorp and Sprout Ventures. Sprout Hub is proving to be a space to connect, learn and earn.

Sprout Hub is currently being used by health and fitness businesses, training companies, local franchises demonstrating their products and services, not for profits organisations and government agencies to provide first aid training, volunteering and youth services.

Portrait - Meet Bev Letton from the Wanneroo Business Association

Bev Letton is the Executive Officer of the Wanneroo Business Association and has recently won the Nifnex Influential 100 Award 2015 for her dedication and inspiring work in the local business community.

Q: Please tell us about the Wanneroo Business Association

Due to our diverse and interesting calendar of events and other member services, the association continues to strengthen and grow; we encourage businesses to engage, connect and tap into the valuable knowledge and experience of fellow members.

Q: Please tell us more about your responsibilities within the association



Bev: My role as Executive Officer is guided by the volunteer Board of Management and involves the day to day running of the association, administration, event management, account management, sales and marketing, membership recruitment and services, stakeholder relationships and much more. I also live locally in the City of Wanneroo meaning that I shop, live and work all within Wanneroo. This brings a huge benefit as I know how it feels to be embraced and part of a community.

Q: Please tell us more about your background prior to joining the Wanneroo Business Association

Bev: I used to be the Co-Director and Business Manager of a Wangara manufacturing business which was then a member of the WBA. When the WBA president at the time approached me to work for the association in January 2008, the decision was not a hard one to make. I had built relationships and made connections with many professionals in the local business community, City of Wanneroo personnel and other organisations through the association. Q: What have been your greatest achievements while working as a business owner and at the Wanneroo Business Association?

Bev: As co-directors we were honoured to receive various City of Wanneroo Small Business Awards for the growth and success of the Furniture Manufacturing Company including awards for Best Manufacturing Business, Best Marketing Business and Best Business.



As the Executive Officer of the WBA, I feel we have achieved much including doubling the membership base of the association since 2008, developing an interactive website, increasing the association's revenue by \$72,100 from 2007 to 2014. On a personal level, whilst working at the Wanneroo Business Association, I was honoured to be awarded at the Nifnex Influential 100 Awards 2015.

Q: How did receiving the Nifnex Influential 100 Awards 2015 change your professional career?

Bev: Winning the Nifnex Influential 100 Awards 2015 has given me an insight as to how much the business community does appreciate and what we do and the support offered. Someone who remains anonymous nominated me. It feels wonderful to be recognised by the small business community whom have also worked hard and achieved such great results; and be considered worthy of such an acknowledgement.

Q: Do you have any words of wisdom for people looking to establish a new business or looking to grow their existing business?

Bev: Never underestimate the power of networking! There is a lot to gain from networking and tapping into the knowledge of other business owners, and there is also a lot to gain in giving back!



Q: What is your favourite quote?

Bev: My favourite quote is: “Our lives begin to end the day we become silent about things that matter” (Martin Luther King Jr) but it might be too heavy for this article so I would say my personal favourite is probably: “Some people don’t believe in Heroes, but they haven’t met my Dad!” (Me).

Expo Success

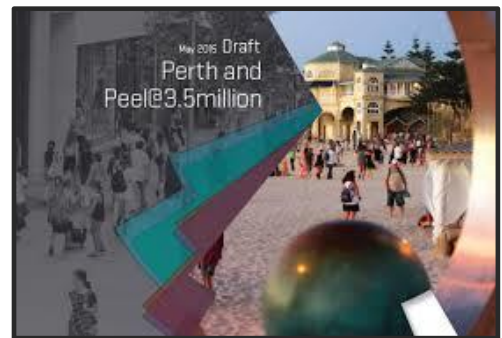
