STRATEGIC COMMUNITY PLAN

In 2012, we listened to our community who told us that the City should focus its efforts on the environment, economy, social aspects and effective governance - and we did.

YANCHEP SURF LIFE SAVING CLUB

The Yanchep Surf Life Saving Club is another step closer with the construction now underway. I inspected the works last week, and was delighted to see it progressing so well.

The local community has waited patiently for this new facility so it is wonderful that it will soon be buzzing with people.

The new facility will comprise club rooms, change-rooms, storage, first-aid facilities, office facilities and car parking and is on track to be complete in November 2016.

ACCESS AND INCLUSION PLAN

The City has launched a new Access and Inclusion Plan to benefit people with disability, as well as the elderly, young parents and people from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds. Improving access, removing barriers and promoting awareness of programs and services available are among the benefits that residents can expect.

The plan was developed following a review of the existing Disability Access and Inclusion Plan which recognised the similarities within multicultural and disability priority services.

MITCHELL FREEWAY PROGRESSING WELL BUT ROMEO ROAD EXTENSION STILL NEEDED

WORK ON THE MITCHELL FREEWAY EXTENSION FROM BURNS BEACH TO HESTER AVENUE IS MAKING GOOD PROGRESS, BUT PLANS TO STOP AT HESTER AVENUE ARE SHORT SIGHTED ACCORDING TO CITY OF WANNEROO MAYOR TRACEY ROBERTS.

"Our residents have waited a long time for the freeway to reach the borders of the City of Wanneroo so the extension is welcome, but the fact remains - the freeway needs to continue beyond Hester Avenue to cater for our rapidly growing community."

Mayor Roberts said the City had spent the last year lobbying the State Government to commit to a freeway extension to Romeo Road.

"An extension to Romeo Road will provide better

transport links to our northern communities and is likely to lead to the early construction of the Wanneroo Road to Marmion Avenue east-west link which is also needed," she said.

"Meanwhile, ending the extension at Hester Avenue will negatively impact the communities of Merriwa, the Mindarie school precinct and RAAFA Cambrai retirement village which already suffer from congestion," she said.

Mayor Roberts said people could join the City's campaign for the freeway extension to Romeo Road, as well as a rail extension to Yanchep, by visiting fundourfuture.info

"I encourage all of our residents to act now and sign the online petition so our voices can be heard by the State and Federal governments."

ARTSPOKENS AFRICAN DRUMMING FOR ADULTS




