COMMUNITY CONSULTATION TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT TREATMENTS – AINSBURY PARADE, CLARKSON

The City is planning to install traffic management treatments on Ainsbury Parade, Clarkson and would value your feedback on what is proposed. This letter provides some background and details of the planned scheme, to make it easier for you to provide your comments.

In accordance with the City's Draft 2016/2017 Capital Works Program, the construction of a part raised/part painted median and blister islands is being considered for Ainsbury Parade from Renshaw Boulevard south to Renshaw Boulevard north. These works have been considered necessary as a result of concerns raised by residents and subsequent assessment of the traffic behaviour in this street.

The proposed traffic management treatments involves the construction of a 1.2m wide painted median including raised median islands between Renshaw Boulevard and Rooke Way as well as two blister Islands located between Rooke Way and Renshaw Boulevard.

The installation of a part-raised/part painted median is an effective method used for road narrowing. Some of the consequential advantages of installing median treatments and blister islands include reduced vehicle speeds and the ability to provide cyclist and pedestrian refuges which can assist when crossing the road.
