The City of Wanneroo is among the first local councils in WA to develop a free 'app' specifically tailored to the needs of its business community.

The 'Biz@Wanneroo' app offers the local business community, partners and stakeholders timely business information, news and events.

For a limited time if you download the app and register, you could win a two month Wanneroo Business Association membership.

Mayor Tracey Roberts said the 'Biz@Wanneroo' app is a new approach that puts the City at the forefront of embracing mobile technology to bring the local business community together.

"The app is easy to use and allows all businesses, from sole trader to mobile operators to communicate with the City and one another," she said.

"Business owners can stay up to date with current and relevant news and opportunities which means they have important information at their fingertips to guide them."

The **Biz@Wanneroo** app was developed by the City's Economic Development team, in partnership with local IT company CommunityToGo.

It's available from the app store (iOS or Android) and businesses are encouraged to switch on notifications to ensure they receive information on key events. Registering contact details also allows businesses to provide feedback, suggest content and email the City direct.

Other features:

- Information on government programs, grants and investment opportunities
- News about what our local businesses are doing
- Business events and training (with option to add to calendar)
- Aggregated news feeds from a number of sources
- Link to the City's website business pages and social media
