December finish for Connolly Drive work

Construction of the Connolly Drive dual carriageway between Clarkson and Butler, over almost 5 kilometres, will be finished early next month.

The City will complete one of its biggest ever road projects when the associated dual carriageway works on Neerabup Road are completed before Christmas.

These works have a combined value of more than \$8.5 million and are part of this year's \$90 million capital works program.

At the peak of construction there was more than \$2 million of plant and equipment engaged on site.

During the Connolly Drive construction more than 59,000 square metres of asphalt was laid to bring the road up to standard. This equates to covering around six soccer pitches or 140 basketball courts.

The works were designed improve the local traffic network and to complement the Main Roads projects on Wanneroo Road and the extension of the Mitchell Freeway.

Firebreak Final Notice

FIREBREAKS MUST BE CLEARED BY TUESDAY 15 NOVEMBER 2016 AND KEPT CLEAR UNTIL SUNDAY 30 APRIL 2017.

Less than 2000sqm - a firebreak no less than 2m wide by 2m high is required around the perimeter and the growth on the firebreak cannot exceed 20mm high.

Greater than 2000sqm - a firebreak no less than 3 metres wide by 3 metres high is required around the perimeter and the growth on the firebreak cannot exceed 20mm high

Burning permits are required all year round. All burning is prohibited from 1 December until the 31 March each year.

This is a requirement under the Bush Fires Act Section 33.


