Wanneroo Road Widening

Joondalup Drive to Flynn Drive

Wanneroo Road / Joondalup Drive Interchange

The Metropolitan Road Improvement Alliance (MRIA), on behalf of Main Roads, is delivering two projects in your area as part of a \$2.3 billion package of road and rail infrastructure projects funded by the Commonwealth and State Governments.

WANNEROO ROAD WIDENING – JOONDALUP DRIVE TO FLYNN DRIVE

This \$31 million project will see Wanneroo Road, between Joondalup Drive and Flynn Drive, widened from one lane to two lanes in both directions to alleviate current congestion and enhance road safety.


The project will involve:

- Construction of 3.2km of dual carriageway on Wanneroo Road within the road reserve
- Intersection upgrades at Golf Links Drive and Carramar Drive
- Noisewalls along the eastern side of Wanneroo Road between Joondalup Drive to north of Carramar Drive, Carramar
- · Drainage, retaining walls and landscaping
- Construction will begin later this year and is anticipated to be completed in late 2018.

Key project activities:

- Detailed design for the project is underway.
- A series of investigation works within the project area have commenced to inform the detailed design.
 - The work includes locating services, environmental investigations, testing the existing condition of the ground and surrounding area, and monitoring existing levels of traffic and noise.

- Activity will continue intermittently until approximately the end of September 2017.
- The majority of the work will take place during standard work hours (Monday-Saturday, 7am-7pm). Some work may need to take place at night. Neighbouring residents will be notified in advance.









A Construction Reference Group is being formed and nominations for community representatives on the group are invited (please see the enclosed information sheet to find out how you can get involved).

 The project team will engage directly with residents and businesses adjacent to the project area regarding property access and noise walls later this month.

WANNEROO ROAD / JOONDALUP DRIVE INTERCHANGE

MRIA is undertaking planning and development for the Wanneroo Road / Joondalup Drive Interchange, which will include a grade separation with Joondalup Drive going over Wanneroo Road with two lanes in each direction.

The project will significantly reduce delays and improve safety at the intersection, which is the sixth most congested in the Perth Metropolitan Area.

This development work will enable Main Roads to undertake the procurement process and award a contract for design and construction in mid-2018.

Key project activities:

- A concept design for the project is being prepared.
- A series of investigation works within the project area will begin in August 2017. These works to inform the concept design will continue intermittently until approximately the end of September 2017.
 - The work includes locating services, environmental investigations, testing the existing condition of the ground and surrounding area, and monitoring existing levels of traffic and noise.
 - The majority of the work will take place during standard work hours (Monday-Saturday, 7am-7pm). Some work may need to take place at night, and neighbouring residents will be notified in advance.

- A Community Liaison Group is being formed and nominations for community representatives on the group are invited (please see the enclosed information sheet to find out how you can get involved).
- A Technical Working Group had been established with the City of Wanneroo and City of Joondalup. The group will assist in confirming project scope, examine the interface with adjacent planned road projects (e.g. modifications to the existing roundabout at Burns Beach Road and Joondalup Drive) and consider potential modifications to other local roads that will help address congestion on the approach to Wanneroo Road from the east and west of the interchange.
- As part of the procurement process, Main Roads will advertise for Expressions of Interest from industry for a detailed design and construction contract at the end of August.
