



## MAYOR'S MESSAGE

In September, the State Government unveiled its 2017/18 budget.

It was fantastic to see their four-year commitment to fund a number of important projects vital to supporting the growth of our City and the lifestyles of our residents.

The budget includes \$520 million to extend the Joondalup Rail Line to Yanchep, \$146 million for upgrades and widening works on Wanneroo Road, \$23 million to complete the widening of Marmion Avenue through to Yanchep Beach Road and

\$500,000 for netball facility upgrades at Kingsway Regional Sporting Complex.

Our schools will also benefit from \$5.4 million in upgrade funding and more than \$30 million for new primary schools in Banksia Grove and Yanchep.

On behalf of Council, Administration and residents, I would like to thank the State Government for listening to the people of the City of Wanneroo and for their support of these important projects.

My sincere thanks also to all our residents who supported the City's Connect Wanneroo campaign and ensured their voices were heard.

On Saturday 7 October, we officially opened the Quinns Mindarie Community Centre, built at a cost of more than \$4 million, with a family fun day.

It was great to see so many people from the local community in attendance to mark the occasion and enjoy the free entertainment and demonstrations by community groups and businesses. The Centre has a range of rooms available to book; please visit our website for further details.

### Registrations and renewals are due 1 Nov

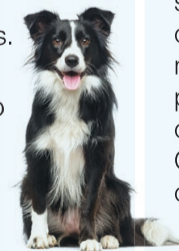


All dogs (over the age of 3 months) and cats (over the age of 6 months) must be registered.
