# **TICKETING**

Please ensure you print out your tickets or have them available to display on your smart phone at the entry gate. Those with City of Wanneroo resident tickets will need to bring along ID with their address on it (i.e. driving license or rates notice). Children 12 years and under will require a child ticket for entry and must be accompanied by an adult. If you need to leave the event site once gates are open you will need to obtain a pass in order to re-enter.

Entry will not be allowed without a valid ticket.

# **FOOD AND DRINK**

There will be a number of vendors selling a variety of food at this event. Water and non-alcoholic drinks will also be available. You are welcome to bring your own picnic but we encourage you to try some of the delicious options available. An ATM will be available on site. This is an alcohol and smoke free event.

Bags will be checked upon entry.

# **GETTING THERE AND BACK**

There will be designated parking areas on site at Paloma South (CP1), Shelvock (CP2) and John Maloney West Parks (CP3).

We anticipate car parks will fill quickly so consider car-pooling or catching public transport. Please follow the directions of all parking marshals and do not park outside the areas indicated or on the street verge. Patrolling rangers may issue infringements for vehicles causing an obstruction. Overflow car parking will be available at Alexander Heights Shopping Centre.

There will be a shuttle bus service running free of charge from CP2 and CP3. When waiting for the shuttle please assemble at the designated points only. There is also a designated drop off area on Paloma Loop.

Transperth bus number 344 passes Paloma Park and departs from Warwick train station.



# **Security & Bag Checks**

Prior to the ticket gate entry we are required to execute a full search of your accompanying bags, to ensure you are not in possession of alcohol or other prohibited items. Event management and security staff reserve the right to confiscate or refuse entry should any items or behaviours be deemed dangerous, hazardous, intimidating or offensive to patrons.

#### **Anti-social Behaviour**

Security and event management reserve the right to refuse admission or to eject a ticket holder for behaviour likely to cause damage, injury, nuisance or annoyance or for failure to comply with reasonable requests. Intoxication, aggressive or anti-social behaviour is unacceptable and will result in ejection from the venue. Anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated. Any person who behaves in this manner may also be removed or handed to the Police.

#### Alcohol

Strictly no alcohol can be brought into the venue. If you arrive intoxicated you will be refused entry. Please don't pre-load and spoil your day.

# No Glass Allowed

Strictly no glass can be brought into the venue. This includes drink bottles, glasses, jars and any other containers or items made of glass.

# **Metal Cutlery**

Strictly no metal cutlery can be brought into the venue. This includes cheese knives. Disposable wooden and plastic cutlery is permitted.

### **Umbrellas**

Strictly no umbrellas can be brought into the venue.

You are welcome to bring a small picnic rug and/or fold up camping chairs. There will be designated 'seating' areas for picnic rugs and low and high-back chairs. Please be mindful to not block the view of others around you. Tents, large items of furniture and inflatable furniture are prohibited at this event.

### **Cameras and Recording Devices**

Professional recording or photography equipment (including drones) will not be permitted at this event unless you are an accredited media representative. Media and professional photographer accreditation must be arranged with the City of Wanneroo prior to the event.

Recording of stage performances using audio, video or photographic equipment is not permitted. Unauthorized or prohibited photography may result in images being deleted by security staff.





We can't judge beforehand if your camera will be deemed professional. It's up to security staff on the day, and debate will not be entered into. The best option is to leave SLR cameras at home and bring a 'point and shoot' camera instead. Generally, cameras with powerful zoom lenses or multiple lenses in a carry case are not allowed. Permission is at the discretion of the City.

# **Smoking**

THIS IS A SMOKE FREE EVENT. There will be a designated smoking area outside of the venue; smoking is not permitted in any other area.

#### Weather

We play rain or shine so please wear appropriate clothing for the forecasted weather conditions. Umbrellas will not be permitted at the event.

If it rains, the show will go on. The show will only be cancelled if conditions are deemed dangerous. The decision to cancel a show will be made on the day of the concert. In the event of inclement weather patrons should check https://www.facebook.com/ CityofWanneroo/ BEFORE departing for the show for messages regarding traffic, parking or wet weather arrangements.

#### **Event Photography**

As a condition of entry, you accept that photographs and video footage of you in the crowd may be used for future marketing purposes.
