

Children's safety a key priority

The City of Wanneroo is working with local schools to improve traffic flow and parking.

Mayor Tracey Roberts said school parking is often an issue for parents during school drop-off and pick-up, however the City is working with schools and families to identify solutions.

"Ensuring the safety of our children as they walk to and from school is a whole-community matter," Mayor Roberts said.

"Traffic flow and parking availability during school drop off and pick up times can create safety hazards for pedestrians as well as road users, with cars parked on verges and

footpaths blocking safe walking areas and lines of sight.

"While many schools have a *Kiss & Ride* area for drop off and pick-up, ineffective use during peak periods can cause knock on effects to surrounding streets, so we are working with school principals to ensure they are operating as smoothly as possible."

According to Mayor Roberts, the key to solving many school parking issues is awareness.

"City of Wanneroo Rangers don't enjoy issuing infringements, so they are proactively working with local schools on strategies to help educate families.



"Throughout the coming months, City Rangers will visit schools to chat with students about the importance of traffic awareness and safe, legal parking."

The City is also providing detailed maps and parking information for schools to share with parents, and will use electronic message boards to let parents know when Rangers will be patrolling.

Community funding support available soon



Each year, the City of Wanneroo's Community Funding Program offers community groups, organisations and clubs the chance to secure financial support for their projects, activities and events.

Incorporated community groups, organisations and clubs based in the City of Wanneroo, or with a primary interest in the City, are eligible to apply through the Program.

Council is particularly supportive of events that connect residents and help build community spirit while encouraging residents to be healthy and active.

Community groups, organisations and clubs with a great idea for a project or event in the City of Wanneroo from February 2019 onwards may be eligible for funding support.

Applications open on 12 September and close on 24 October 2018.
