# TENDER 23160 DESIGN, SUPPLY, AND INSTALLATION OF AQUAMOTION SPLASHPAD RENEWAL, WANNEROO

#### Issue

To consider the decline of Tender No: 23160 for the design, supply, and installation of the Aquamotion splashpad renewal, Wanneroo.

## **Background**

Aquamotion centre is located at 19 Civic Drive, Wanneroo. The existing amenities include:

- Indoor and outdoor pools, Splashpad, Hot spa;
- Gym;
- Playground, Gazebos, BBQs & picnic tables;
- Shade sails;
- Toilet facility:
- Café and creche.

The splashpad was constructed in 2009 as part of the extension of the Aquamotion centre. The equipment is aging, and the surface is starting to deteriorate. The scope of the project is to renew the splashpad equipment and surface, and the provision of universal access.

#### Detail

Tender 23160 for the design, supply, and installation of Aquamotion splashpad renewal, Wanneroo was advertised on 4 October 2023 and closed on 20 October 2023. An addendum was issued during the process to provide additional information to Tenderers.

Tender submissions were evaluated in accordance with the Procurement and Evaluation Plan (**PEP**) which included the following selection criteria:

All tenderers must meet the City's minimum requirements (as determined by the City) for each of the qualitative criteria detailed above (\*) to be considered for further evaluation.

Pricing is not included in the qualitative criteria and is considered as part of the overall value for money assessment.

#### **Overall Assessment and Comment**

The Tender Evaluation Panel (TEP) concluded that neither submission was acceptable as the tenderers did not meet the City's required scope and specifications and therefore all tender submissions are to be declined.
