

- Volunteers are covered by the LGIS Liability Scheme for Public Liability and Professional Indemnity and Personal Accident [per the conditions/terms/exclusions of policies].
As long as they are direct volunteers of Council [i.e. Registered with the City on the volunteers register] and under the direct control of a City of Wanneroo employee.
Volunteers must understand and agree on the details and scope of the work to be undertaken.
- No cover for theft of volunteer's personal items.
- No cover for volunteer's personal motor vehicle insurance, except as below:
There is some cover for volunteer's motor vehicles - as long as the City has authorised the use and damage was sustained in the execution of the volunteers duties - this will not normally include travel to and/or from place of work.
- Personal Accident Cover
Includes Council volunteers whilst the volunteer is engaged in voluntary work authorised by and under the control of the Council, as well as when travelling directly to and from such voluntary work.
- Insurance cover is provided for persons aged between 16 and 75 years of age.
- Restricted cover for volunteers aged under 16; and between 75 to 90 years of age.
- Excludes cover for incorporated bodies.
