"Wanneroo Aquamotion is an icon for the region, and is one of several major projects which makes up the greater Wanneroo Town Centre Revitalisation project."

Facilities include a state-of-the-art fitness centre with gym and group fitness room, an outdoor deep-water pool, children's splash pad, hydrotherapy pool, plus upgrades to the existing indoor pools.

Prior to the Family Fun Day there will be a special VIP function, which will include the official opening of the fitness and leisure centre.

Wanneroo Aquamotion is a Wanneroo Town Centre Revitalisation Partnership project of the City of Wanneroo and the Government of Western Australia.

## Recycle your old batteries

RESIDENTS CAN NOW DISPOSE OF OLD HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES (DRY-CELL) AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF WANNEROO.

Introduced last week, this community initiative is the first of its kind in Australia and gives everyone the ability to recycle common household batteries.

Wanneroo Mayor Jon Kelly said the City of Wanneroo would have bins at the new Wanneroo Library and Cultural Centre, Wanneroo Aquamotion, Clarkson Library, Girrawheen Library and the Yanchep Community Centre.

**"Each year approximately 18 million household batteries are thrown away in WA alone,"** Mayor Kelly said. **"When batteries go to landfill, their casings disintegrate and metals and chemicals used within the battery can seep into the surrounding environment."**

"By separating batteries from ordinary household rubbish, they can be recycled into a range of new products, including street lights and car parts."

The City will collect the batteries regularly, with the batteries stored at the Operations Centre for collection by the Mindarie Regional Council.

The types of batteries accepted include: AA and AAA cells (single use & rechargeable batteries), C and D sized batteries, Button batteries (e.g. from watches), 9V batteries; and 6V batteries (e.g. lantern/torch batteries).

The initiative is managed by the Mindarie Regional Council with the support of the other four metropolitan regional councils, and supported by the Western Australian Landfill Levy Fund and Household Hazardous Waste Program.

#### NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

- A completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. This form is available from the Returning Officer, the Western Australian Electoral Commission Website ([waec.wa.gov.au](http://waec.wa.gov.au)) or the City of Wanneroo.
- A single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of information about the candidate.
- A nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, bank cheque or postal order).
- A recent passport-sized photograph (optional). Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate. The documents may be hand delivered, posted or faxed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.
