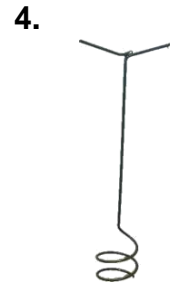
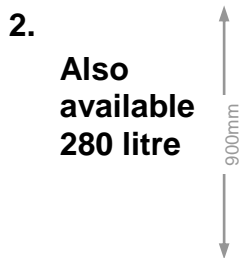

COMPOST MATE

The Compost Mate provides a fast, convenient and effective means of operating your compost bin. A few minutes work with the Compost Mate each week will help to create the perfect conditions inside your bin for composting to happen.

How to use the COMPOST MATE:

1. Screw the tool into your compost to the required depth, where it captures a 'plug' of material.
2. The captured plug of compost can be lifted to the surface with the tool. Tap the tool to release the captured material and repeat in several positions to aerate the entire contents of your compost bin.
3. After repeating the process in several locations, the contents of the bin will be thoroughly aerated and 'fluffed', helping the material to break down faster.
4. Aerate your compost with the Compost Mate as required (this will help prevent smells in active compost piles) – typically twice a week in summer, and fortnightly in winter.
5. Use the Compost Mate to remove finished compost from the bottom of the bin to use around your garden.
