

VOLUNTEERING ROLES

Please find below an example of volunteering roles with the City of Wanneroo.



CONSERVATION – VARIOUS LOCATIONS

Assist in planting and revegetation programs at various locations throughout city or help with cleaning up of public spaces and coastal reserves under the guidance of the Conservation Management Officer.

This volunteering is great for School Groups and Corporate Volunteering Programs.



HERITAGE – BUCKINGHAM HOUSE

To assist with the education programs for school children on Tuesdays and Fridays during school terms. Volunteers assist with a variety of activities such as making damper, washing and ironing clothes, sewing and fun outside games like marbles and hop scotch.



COMMUNITY AND FAMILY HISTORY – WANNEROO LIBRARY & CULTURAL CENTRE

To assist the Community History Librarian with the development, organisation and maintenance of collection materials in the Community History Centre such as indexing newspapers, sorting and scanning photographs; archive and ephemera collections and preparing images for inclusion in an online database. Cataloguing experience is desirable.



SPORTSLINK - KINGSWAY

To assist the Sportslink Co-ordinator with planning and facilitating Sportslink Program encouraging and engaging children aged 7 – 12 years with a disability to develop sporting skills and confidence. Siblings of the participants are encouraged to join in also.



SEWING GROUP – BANKSIA GROVE COMMUNITY CENTRE

Volunteer assists members of the sewing group to lay and cut out patterns and learn and enhance their sewing skills.

COMPUTER TUTOR – VARIOUS LOCATIONS

Provide basic computer instruction to clients attending computer tuition sessions.



BOOKS ON WHEELS - LIBRARIES

The volunteer assists by selecting library books for patrons as per their likes and requests. The role includes bundling and tagging items in preparation and researching and reserving items for patrons.



HERITAGE – COCKMAN HOUSE

Cockman House is a heritage listed building within the City of Wanneroo which is open on Sunday afternoons to the public. Volunteers open, close and secure the property and provide information to people visiting the home. At times Volunteers also conduct tours for visiting groups.

If you are interested in gardening, volunteers also tend to the vegetable patch at Cockman House.



TRANSPORT DRIVERS & BUS AIDS – VARIOUS LOCATIONS

Volunteers use City of Wanneroo vehicles to drive clients on community excursions, shopping trips and to and from community centres. An 'F' class endorsement is required and further information can be found on the Department of Transport's website.



ADULT DAY CENTRE – VARIOUS LOCATIONS

Volunteers assist in activities at City run Adult Day Centres by interacting with clients by participating in activities such as card games, quizzes and board games; carrying out basic food preparation and undertaking other duties as directed by the Centre Based Day Care Supervisor.
