

## OVERVIEW

The City of Wanneroo's Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades provide a fire prevention and suppression service for the municipality, which encompasses an area of 685 square kilometres.

Approximately 160 volunteers work rostered times throughout the year with either the Wanneroo Fire Support Brigade, Quinns Rocks, Two Rocks, and Wanneroo Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades.

The City of Wanneroo's Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades also assist other Local Government Bush Fire Brigades and at the request of FESA, also operate within the gazetted fire district. They assist the WA Fire and Rescue Service and the Department of Environment and Conservation (DEC) in times of emergency.

## HOW TO BECOME A MEMBER

To be eligible for one of the City of Wanneroo's Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades, you must attend at least three of the monthly meetings held with your respective Brigade.

At your first meeting, the Brigade Recruitment Officer will explain the membership details, roles and responsibilities.

Before becoming active members, all eligible recruits will undergo a medical examination and basic training. (This cost will be paid by the City of Wanneroo)

After two years of active service and extended training, members may then be qualified as crew leaders and to drive vehicles under emergency fire call conditions. (lights and sirens)

## WHICH BRIGADE DO I JOIN?

### 1. Wanneroo Fire Support Brigade

If you reside north of Gnangara Road and Whitfords Ave, you are eligible for membership in the Wanneroo Fire Support Brigade.

If you reside in Butler, Carabooda, Clarkson, Jindalee, Merriwa, Mindarie, Neerabup, Nowergup, Quinns Rocks or Ridgewood you are eligible for membership in the Quinns Rocks Brigade.

## STRUCTURE OF THE BRIGADE

### COMMUNITY FIRE MANAGER (CFM)

### CHIEF BUSH FIRE CONTROL OFFICER (CBFCO)

The CBFCO is the most senior position in the Fire Service. This person is responsible for making decisions concerning the direction of the Brigade.

The CFM / CBFCO provides the link between the City of Wanneroo, FESA Fire Services and the Volunteer Bush Fire Brigades.

### DEPUTY CHIEF BUSH FIRE CONTROL OFFICER (DCBFCO)

The DCBFCO'S assists the CBFCO, and in their absence attends as the most senior officer of the Fire Service.

### FIRE CONTROL OFFICERS (FCO)

The FCO assists the CBFCO and the DCBFCO'S of the Fire Services.

### CAPTAIN

Each Brigade has a Captain, and is elected each year at the Annual General Meeting (AGM). They chair the monthly meetings and are the highest ranked officers in each Brigade.

### LIEUTENANTS

Lieutenants assist the Captain, and are also elected at the AGM.
