

Keep OurPlace Safe

The City of Wanneroo is urging residents to be involved in the safety of their own neighbourhood with the launch of a new community initiative - OurPlace.

Wanneroo Mayor Tracey Roberts said the City of Wanneroo initiative aimed to encourage public participation to maintain a safe community.

"The City of Wanneroo is already a great place to live, with strong working relationships between WA Police, Neighbourhood Watch and the City's own Rangers and Community Safety Patrols,"

Mayor Roberts said.

"However, a whole of community approach is important as community safety is the responsibility of everyone. So we are encouraging our residents to behave responsibly and report those who do not."

Over recent years the City has made a huge commitment to community safety, with the installation of a CCTV network, return of community safety patrols, increasing partnerships with WA Police, and introduction of the Eyes on the Street campaign, which is strengthening the City's commitment to delivering a safer community.
