

Proposed Banksia Grove Dog Park

Project Details

This project is a result of funding provided to the City through the Office of MLA Rita Saffioti, member for West Swan and in consultation with the Banksia Grove Residents Association.

Conditions of the funding have specified that the dog park facility is to be located within the Banksia Grove community. The City's Administration have investigated the available parks within Banksia Grove and identified potential locations for the dog park in consultation with Banksia Grove Residents Association.

Below is a summary of the locations that were investigated

Viridian Park	Land Parcel is sufficient size, however there are conservation restrictions.
Celadon Park	Land Parcel is sufficient size, however there are conservation restrictions.
Delamare Park	Land Parcel is sufficient size, street parking available, other green space to the north. Potential impacts on current use
Banksia Grove District Open Space	Land Parcel is sufficient size, however there is limited space due to existing sporting and educational activities and skate park
Pulchella Park	Small in size. Would require development of entire site for a dog park leaving no other space. Drainage function creates restrictions. Limited parking.
Discovery Park	Some clearing may be required, drainage function creates restrictions, parking issues currently exist at this site as park is heavily used.

Current Status
