

CARRAMAR VILLAGE WISH LIST

Possible Off-Site Actions to Reduce Private Vehicle Dependency.



Underpass

Improve public safety of pedestrian underpass users.

Minor Landscaping

Reduce height of undergrowth to improve visual connectivity to school and surveillance of car park.

On Street Parking and Pick Up

Facilitate creation of on street parking to formalise existing practice during school pick up hours and during sporting fixtures.

Traffic Flow

Modify traffic flow to one way to compliment proposed modification of internal vehicle movement network.

Break in Parking Fencing

Create/install pedestrian gates to oval to improve pedestrian permeability, thereby creating a more efficient walkable catchment. At present the fence to the oval forms a physical barrier.

Increase Walkabout Catchment

Improve pedestrian line of sight and reduce the walking distance via creation of pedestrian promenade.

Create Integrated Piazza

Improve community centre function and use of piazza through paving, increased shade trees, retaining and an improved activated façade (community centre).

Improving the piazza space would capitalise the modified internal movement network of shopping centre and activated land uses.

Pedestrian Promenade

Create promenade to connect new shopping centre entrance with pedestrian movement network. Discouraging use of loading area as thoroughfare.

Connect Carparks

Improve integration and function of car parking areas to facilitate reciprocal parking agreement between Canute and City of Wanneroo.

Disability Access

Minor pedestrian network improvements to fix disability access blackholes

Traffic Calming

Introduce traffic calming measures to reduce vehicle speed on exit of roundabout.

Connect with School

Request for City engagement with Carramar Primary School.

Request for Eat Street

Programmed activity – food trucks to boost night time economy.

Minor LandscapingReduce height of undergrowth to improve visual connectivity to school and surveillance of car park.



Improve lighting conditions with regard to spacing and alignment to pathways and relevant landscaping.

Reduce the opportunity for concealment.



Improve general maintenance and management of the underpass-increase in security patrols is a suggested response.



Establish direct sightlines so that access points are not impeded by dense landscaping.



On-Street Parking and Pick-Up Facilitate creation of on-street parking to formalise existing practice during school pickup hours and during sporting fixtures.

Improve integration and function of car parking areas to facilitate reciprocal parking agreement between Canute and City of Wanneroo.















Traffic Calming

Introduce traffic calming measures to reduce vehicle speed on exit of roundabout.

Upcoming Major Road Network Changes:

- New roundabout proposed in lieu of traffic lights and;
- New Joondalup Drive/Wanneroo Road flyover is proposed to commence in mid-2018. This will result in a constant flow of traffic, without the natural rhythm currently generated by traffic lights. This will make pedestrian crossings of Joondalup Drive more difficult, placing greater emphasis on improving pedestrian underpass and implementing traffic calming measures



Traffic calming measures are required to reduce vehicle speed on exit of roundabout, thereby improving pedestrian safety.
