

## Management Plan for Airbnb at 21 Compass Circle, Yanchep 6035

### 1. Maximum number of guests

- The maximum number of registered guests allowed is 6 at any one time.
- · No visitors/non registered guests allowed.
- No pets allowed.

#### 2. Guest Car Parking

- On site parking is available on driveway for up to 6 cars.
- There will be no disruption to neighbouring properties.

## 3. Expected behaviour and obligations of guests

- A Code of Conduct & House Rules will be placed in the information file on the dining table of 21 Compass Circle, Yanchep. (Appendix A)
- A complaints management procedure providing contact numbers for both Julie & Robert Saunders (owners & managers of the property), will be placed in the information file on the dining table of 21 Compass Circle, Yanchep. (Appendix B)
- Contact numbers for both Julie & Robert Saunders (owners & managers of the property), will
  provided to adjoining neighbours in case of guest noise or bad behaviour. All calls will be
  responded to promptly and action taken to resolve any problems or incidents in a timely
  manner.
- · All complaints, problems and incidents will be recorded and logged as per Appendix C

## 4. Check-in and check-out procedures

- Guests will be required to provide an estimated time of arrival at time of booking (check in is between 2:30pm 9.00pm) and to notify the owners of any unforeseen delays.
- Guests will be provided with instructions of the location and code of the key safe to obtain the property keys on day of arrival.
- Guests will be required to check out by 10:30am and will be provided with instructions regarding securing of keys in key safe.
- The owners will inspect the property after 10:30 on day of check out. Guests will be refunded their deposit less any costs for damages.

#### 5. Waste Management

- Guests are expected to dispose of general rubbish and recycling as per Code of Conduct & House Rules, Appendix A.

#### 9. Additional Information

The property is situated 200 metres from the beach and provides an excellent tourism opportunity in an area which currently has a limited range of holiday accommodation available.
