Dordaak Kepap, New Library and Youth Innovation Hub, 15 The Broadview, Landsdale

During this latest phase of community engagement, the City is asking our community to share their views on the design and construction concept of Dordaak Kepap; the new Library and Youth Innovation Hub to be built at 15 The Broadview, Landsdale.

Your feedback on the proposed design and ideas for services, programs and activities the facility could offer are valued.

Dordaak Kepap will be adjacent to Broadview Park and the Lansdale Shopping Forum in Landsdale.

The proposed concept is sustainable, modern and environmentally considered. As well as a library and youth innovation hub, the facility will offer work, study and meeting room spaces.

In addition to the library; the facility will offer multifunction spaces and meeting rooms, a youth innovation hub, IT and activated spaces.

The proposed concept is estimated to cost \$9.25 million and has been designed to provide the community with a feature-rich facility to meet community needs now and into the future.

The overall project budget is \$10.5 million; the City is investing \$7.5 million towards the project and the State Government WA Recovery Plan is investing \$3m to fund the youth innovation hub.

Construction is anticipated to commence in 2023, with completion in 2024.
