Food vendors wishing to trade at approved events should complete the Food Notification and Registration Form, unless already registered/notified. <u>Please note:</u> Trailers requiring to be towed by a vehicle are generally not suitable for street or carpark trading. In particular they must have provided Notification to the Local Authority.
