Who can enter?

- 3. The competition is open to both amateur and professional photographers.
- 4. The Youth entry is classed as age 16 and under, as at 31 December 2015.
- 5. The Adult entry is classed as above the age of 16, as at 31 December 2015.
- 6. Entrants may submit up to three photographs. Any additional photographs submitted will not be judged by the panel and will be disqualified from winning a prize.

Guidelines

- Entrants may submit up to three photographs, however multiple prize winners will not be allowed. The photograph must be taken after 1 August 2015 and be of subject matter within the **City of Wanneroo** council area.
- Artwork must be original and photographed by the entrant and not infringe any party's intellectual property rights.
- Photographs can be black and white, or colour.
- Images should not be digitally enhanced, other than cropped or re-sized as appropriate. Composite images are not acceptable.
- Photographs must be supplied in high quality resolution, in the following format;-JPEG, TIFF

Terms and Conditions

- The promoter is the City of Wanneroo. Australian Business Number 64 295 981 165.
- All photographs must be of attractions/locations within the City of Wanneroo.
- Elected Members, officers and employees of the City of Wanneroo and their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition.
- Entrants using images containing people including children must provide a model release form for each person when submitting the entry. Model release forms for children must be
 signed by a parent or guardian.
- The City of Wanneroo reserves the right to refuse entry to the competition, where it deems an individual's right to privacy has been compromised.
- Any photograph that has won a prize previously in any competition is not eligible for entry.
- Competition prizes cannot be redeemed as cash.
- By entering this competition, consent in given for the copyright of the photograph(s) entered, to be transferred to the City of Wanneroo.
- The City reserves the right to use the photographs for various media formats including, but not limited to advertisements,

- Image size must be no smaller than 1MB (or 500kb for Youth).
- Digital images must be submitted online via the web application form.
- All entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form and model release form where required.
- A description of up to 30 words must accompany each photograph. This should include where the photograph was taken and how it represents the City.
- There is one subject category for all entrants; Professional, Amateur, Youth and Instagram. Celebrate what is great about living and visiting the City of Wanneroo. Capture images of people enjoying the City's unique experiences.
