

Templeton Crescent – Local Traffic Management Plan Study

In response to concerns raised by residents regarding excessive speeding and erratic driving along Templeton Crescent, the City of Wanneroo has commissioned Transport Engineering consultants "Cardno" to complete a Study of Templeton Crescent, to consider the installation of Traffic Management to assist in remediating the issues being faced.

The study will investigate traffic survey data, on-site observations and also consult with the local community, to identify a proposed solution befitting the areas needs and dealing with the issues as investigated throughout the study.

The purpose of consulting with the community is to allow residents to have an opportunity to voice their concerns on any proposed treatment options and to ensure the proposal satisfies the needs of the community whilst providing safe movement for all modes of travel.




Figure 1. Traffic Management Study Area

Starting from 07th January 2015 residents within the Templeton crescent Traffic Management Study Area (refer to Figure 1), will start to receive information that relates to the traffic management proposal options and outlines how to participate in the community consultation process. This survey period will end on Monday 2nd February.
