

The City, as part of it's approved 2014/2015 Capital Works Program, is proposing to install subsoil drainage in Jimbub Swamp Park, Tapping.

The works will comprise of:

- Excavation works
- Installation of subsoil drainage
- Backfilling works
- Reinstatement of turf and reticulation

Work is scheduled to commence on Monday 23 February 2015, with completion anticipated within two (2) weeks from commencement (weather permitting). The exact timing may vary depending upon the availability of the City's contractors. Note that fencing will be erected on Friday 20 February 2015.

Part of Jimbub Swamp Park will be temporarily closed to allow the works to be carried out in a safe and efficient manner. The worksite will be fenced-off as per attached plan indicating the extent of the works.

During construction, relevant signage will be in place about the partial closure of the park for the duration of the works.

Whilst it is inevitable that works of this nature will cause some inconvenience, every endeavour will be made to ensure that this is kept to a minimum. This is part of a three stage process to ensure that the facility will provide a useable space for sporting teams in the future. The City considers that this project will improve resident safety and your support and co-operation would be greatly appreciated.
