YOUR SAY Fenced dog exercise areas

In response to requests from residents of the City of Wanneroo, a pilot fenced dog exercise park will be funded in the 2012/13 Capital Budget.

The proposed location for the fenced exercise area is Sheffield Park, Wanneroo from Montreal to Sheffield Street.

The location is central within the boundaries of the City of Wanneroo with a great flat grassed reserve which is not used for regular sporting events. With an internal path network, allowing access for people with disabilities and on-street parking, this area is perfect for exercising your dog.

The area will be marked out by approximately 450 metres of 1.2 metre high PVC coated chain link fencing with up to six pedestrian entry/exit gates, and one double entry/exit gate to allow access by Council maintenance vehicles.

The City of Wanneroo invites public comment on the proposed construction of the Fenced Dog Exercise area within Sheffield Park.
