# Mitchell Freeway Extension: Burns Beach Road to Hester Avenue

# **WORKS OVERVIEW**

Major earthworks are underway with approximaltey 3.5 million tonnes of existing material expected shifted by project completion. Where possible, material is being re-used within the project area however some material will need to be taken off-site.

During August, Construction Reference Group (CRG) representatives participated in walk-throughs of the Neerabup Road and Wanneroo Road alignments to identify specific native trees that may be retained. The next meeting with the CRG will be held in early September.
