Key

- ① basket swing with rubber and pine bark softfall
- ② spring units
- ③ double swings
- ④ slide
- ⑤ mound with log steps, rock climb, limestone steps and a grass bank
- ⑥ picnic tables
- ⑦ The entrance to the playground is the only access point for the public with the entire playground enclosed by a fence.
- ⑧ Sand play
- ⑨ Water channel with log bridges
- ⑩ Teepee
- ⑪ Timber logs
- ⑫ Timber steppers and decks
- ⑬ Timber steppers form a maze for peekaboo games
- ⑭ Timber seats and panels used to create a bus
- ⑮ sensory planting and new trees
- ⑯ grass area

Playground design

The playground has been designed to integrate traditional play elements with natural elements such as logs, rocks and planting. This creates play opportunities for children to play and practise their motor skills while exploring different materials and textures.

The eastern side of the playground is the active play area including an earth mound with slides, a picnic area, grass runabout and two types of swings.

The western area has a teepee, logs and steppers integrated between the existing trees. The northern area has sand play and a water channel as well as a seating area and new tree planting.
