Mitchell Freeway Extension: Burns Beach Road to Hester Avenue

WORKS OVERVIEW

Works will continue across the project area throughout December and January including earthworks and the installation of noise walls and drainage.

There will be a two week Christmas shutdown from December 19 2015 to January 3 2016. Site maintenance activities will be undertaken intermittently throughout the shutdown period.

From January works will ramp-up along Hester Avenue and Burns Beach Road.





Excavators, trucks and water carts continue to operate along near Kinross as part of the earthworks to establish the freeway levels.

UPCOMING WORKS

Location	Activities
Currambine	 Vegetation and fence removal in the median along the future freeway. Night works to install access points to the work area from the freeway off and on-ramps and Burns Beach Road. Preparation works to extend the existing pedestrian underpasses on both sides of Currabmine Train Station. The footpath and underpasses will remain open during these works.
Kinross	Earthworks, drainage installation and noise wall preparation works. The delivery of limestone sub-base, concrete, pipes and other materials via Burns Beach Road will be required.
	Works to protect the water main at the northern end of Kinross, involving excavation and culvert installation.
	Treatment of mulched vegetation.
	Closure of the footpath on the southern side of Burns Beach Road (under the rail bridge). Pedestrians and cyclists are able to use the underpasses at Currambine Train Station as an alternate route.







Location	Activities
Clarkson	Earthworks and drainage installation, including the excavation for the Neerabup Road combined bus/pedestrian underpass.
	 Installation of steel sheet piles to support the existing Hester Avenue existing bridge during construction.
	Installation of noise walls on the western side of the freeway alignment. Ongoing material deliveries via Connolly Drive and Hester Avenue will support these works.
	Treatment of mulched vegetation.
Ridgewood / Clarkson	Earthworks between Ridgewood Boulevard and Wanneroo Road.
Hester Avenue from Ridgewood Boulevard to Wanneroo Road	Night works to move Hester Avenue traffic onto a temporary road alignment in early December. This will provide the necessaryspace to facilitate upgrade works.
	Relocation of existing services including communication and gas lines. Night works will be required in January to relocate a section of gas main under the train line.
Neerabup Wanneroo Road from Hall Road to Flynn Drive	Earthworks and installation of drainage.
	Construction of temporary road pavement in the median just north of Hall Road.
	 Various adjustments to existing services, including the relocation of a section of the transmission line and protection of the gas main and sewer line.

WORK HOURS

Works will be conducted Monday to Saturday from 7am to 7pm. Site maintenance, such as refuelling and dust suppression, will be undertaken outside of these times.

Where works are required outside of these hours, we will ensure local residents are notified.

TRAFFIC CHANGES

Speed reductions and lane closures will be in place throughout the project. Signage will be in place to guide motorists through these changed traffic conditions.
