As a result of the ward boundaries review I am now your Councillor for the North Coast Ward

taking in the suburbs of Two Rocks, Yanchep, Eglington, Merriwa, Clarkson, Mindarie, Alkimos, Jindalee, Quinns Rocks, Butler and Ridgewood.

This will now allow for a more cohesive approach to Council's work, in that all of the suburbs that share our coast and Marmion Avenue fall within this new ward. Being half way through my four year term, it is a fitting time to take the opportunity to reflect.

Taking in 32kms of coastline, our commitment to community safety on our beaches is evident in the \$4.28M allocated to upgrade the Quinns Mindarie Community Centre and associated Surf Life Saving Club, and the \$6.4M construction of the new Yanchep Surf Life Saving Club due to start construction in early 2016.

The installation of a shark barrier at southern end of Quinns Beach is also currently being investigated. We encourage residents to have their say and complete the online survey available on the City's website until Monday 14 December 2015.

The City is also undertaking important work with the Coastal Hazard Risk Management and Adaptation Plan (CHRMAP) which will help to guide the important work of protecting our beautiful coastline from erosion and will help guide the development decisions we are faced with.

With climate change on the world agenda at the recent UN Climate Change Conference in Paris, it is satisfying to know our draft Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation Strategy will be ready to be released next year. We look forward to community feedback on this important work which is a key action in our Strategic Community Plan.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish all residents, a wonderful Christmas and a safe festive season. I am really excited about 2016 and working with you on the opportunities and challenges that our growth continues to bring. I would welcome your thoughts.
