



### TICKETING

Please print out your tickets and bring them with you on the day. Those with City of Wanneroo residents tickets will need to bring along ID with their address on it. Children twelve years and under will require a child's ticket for entry and must be accompanied by an adult. If you need to leave the event site once gates are open you will need to obtain a pass out wristband. **Entry will not be allowed without a valid ticket.**

### GETTING THERE AND BACK

There will be designated parking areas on site at Liddell South (CP1), Templeton (CP2), Blackmore (CP3) and Hudson (CP4) Parks. We anticipate car parks will fill quickly so consider car pooling or catching public transport. Please follow the directions of all parking marshals and do not park outside the areas indicated or on the street verge. There will be a shuttle bus service running free of charge from CP3 and CP4. When waiting for the shuttle please assemble at the designated points only, off the roads. There is also a designated drop off area on Greville Way outside Templeton Park.

### TIMING

Gates are open to the public at 4pm and will close at 7.30pm, at which point entry will not be allowed. Set times are:

Some activities do not run for the entire event and can only cater for limited numbers. We suggest coming down early if you want to enjoy them all.

### FOOD AND DRINK

There will be a number of food vendors selling a variety of food from around the world. Water and non-alcoholic drinks will also be available. You are welcome to bring your own picnic but we do encourage you to try the delicious food options available. An ATM will be available on site.

**This is an alcohol and smoke free event.** Bags will be checked upon entry.

- We play rain or shine so please wear appropriate clothing for the forecasted weather conditions. Umbrellas will not be permitted onto the event site.
