

Efficient lighting is becoming more important with the increase in electricity prices, and choice of lighting types is growing exponentially. One of the most efficient forms of lighting are LED's as displayed in this home.

LED lighting is 60-80% cheaper to run and lasts 15 times longer than typical halogen lights. The downlights are sealed to stop dust entering the home and prevent winter heat leaving. They also do not get as hot as traditional lighting, thus reducing risk of ceiling fires. Although more expensive initially, experts believe the capital costs will be recouped in 1 - 4 years depending on usage.
