- ³ Process, in relation to food, means activity conducted to prepare food for sale including, chopping, cooking, drying, fermenting, heating, pasteurising or a combination of these activities.
- ⁴ Vulnerable Persons as defined in Standard 3.3.1 Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code eg Child Care Centres,
- ⁵ Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) defines shelf stable as non-perishable food with a shelf life of many months to years, while perishable food is not shelf stable. Perishable foods are those likely to spoil, decay or become unsafe to consume if not kept refrigerated at 5 °C or below or frozen. Examples of foods that must be kept refrigerated for safety include meat, poultry, fish, dairy products, and all cooked food.
- ⁶ An Exempt Food Business is one of the following:
 - Food business is conducted to raise money solely for purposes that are of a charitable or community nature;
 any food handled in the course of conducting the food business is not potentially hazardous food; or after being appropriately cooked, is provided by the food business for immediate consumption.
 - Food business consists solely of selling food that is not potentially hazardous food and that cannot be handled in the course of conducting the food business because the food is contained in a closed package.
