TRAFFIC IMPACT

Lane closures will be in place on Burns Beach Road and the Mitchell Freeway off-ramp.

Signage will be in place to guide road users through the works.

WORK ACTIVITIES

Night works will include:

- Potholing
- Removing median islands
- Installing traffic barriers
- Installing and removing traffic management.

Works must be undertaken during night shift due to high day time traffic volumes.

Hester Avenue, Neerabup

Night works will be undertaken intermittently on **Hester Avenue between Wanneroo Road** and the **Joondalup train line** from **7pm to 5am, 26 April to late May 2016** (weather permitting).

TRAFFIC IMPACT

For the safety of motorists and workers, the speed limit through the worksite will be reduced to 40km/h.

There may be short periods of time where traffic travelling on Hester Avenue will be stopped.

Road users are asked to take extra care when travelling through this area and follow all traffic management in place.

WORK ACTIVITIES

Night works will include:

- altering overhead rail electrical lines
- locating underground services
- installing and removing barriers and traffic management
- installing and removing line-marking
- earthworks
- pavement construction
- laying asphalt.

Equipment will include various plant and machinery such as graders, rollers and compactors.

Works must be undertaken during night shift due to day time traffic volumes and the safety requirements when working in a rail corridor.
