

KINGSWAY INDOOR STADIUM

CODE OF CONDUCT

Overview

Patrons who utilise the facilities at Kingsway Indoor Stadium are required to demonstrate behaviours that support a social and friendly atmosphere for all patrons to spectate and participate in a variety of sports, recreation programs and events.

Any patron failing to comply with the Code of Conduct or requests from City of Wanneroo staff may be ejected from the facility, and/or subject to other or further disciplinary action at the complete discretion of Kingsway Indoor Stadium management.

Behaviour of patrons

- Treat all participants as you'd like to be treated
- Respect the privacy and personal space of other individuals
- Respect the facility and all those who use it
- Look after your fellow patron and clean up after yourselves where reasonable
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your Team Captain approach the official during a break or after the game
- Control your temper as abuse of officials, sledging other players, and deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable behaviours in any sport
- Be a good sport and participate for the social enjoyment and well-being of social sport
- · Obey all lawful instructions as provided by City of Wanneroo staff
- Maintain the highest level of sportsmanship and duty of care for fellow patrons
- Respect and adhere to all Kingsway Indoor Stadium, rules, by-laws, conditions and declarations
- The behaviour and responsibility of children is that of the parent / guardians, or the Hirer who is responsible for those children

The following points are not permitted or tolerated within Kingsway Indoor Stadium or its grounds at any time:

- Unacceptable language or actions, including but not limited to abusive, aggressive, antagonistic, anti-social, disrespectful, discriminatory, offensive, racist, or threatening language or actions
- Playing under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs
- · Fighting or violence of any nature
- Disruptive unsportsmanlike conduct on or off the field
- Dissent or disrespect towards City of Wanneroo staff
- Warm-up or other similar activities in walkways, viewing areas, or foot traffic areas
