## 1. Real Property

Real property refers to land or things attached to land such as a house, shed or jetty for instance. An interest includes but is not limited to a financial interest, a right or power of attorney for someone who is elderly or if you hold shares in the property.

A designated employee does not have to disclose interest in real property if they are the executor of a deceased estate or a trustee as part of their occupation or by way of security for a debt.

The address or description (e.g. Certificate of Title details) of any land in which the
designated employee has an interest must be disclosed. A post office box number
would not be adequate since the purpose is to identify the actual land or property.

 Only property located in the local government district or the neighbouring local government district with which your local government has a common boundary must be disclosed.

**Example**: If a designated employee represented Wanneroo and also owned property in Joondalup both would need to be disclosed. However a property owned in Margaret River would not be required to be disclosed.

• If there is no interest to disclose under a question, indicate this on the return by answering not applicable to the question.
