NEW SHARED PATHS FOR HARTMAN DRIVE AND OCEAN REEF ROAD

THE CITY OF WANNEROO WILL SOON BE A SAFER PLACE FOR CYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS THANKS TO AN INVESTMENT OF MORE THAN \$480,000 IN THE 2016/17 BUDGET.

The \$132,000 Hartman Drive project is set to be a 330m shared path on the west side from Kingsway to Westport Parade.

The path will improve cyclist and pedestrian connections between Madeley, Darch and Wangara including Kingsway Christian College, Ashdale Secondary College, Ashdale Primary School and Madeley Primary School.

Northern Beaches Cycling Group President and member of the City's North Coast Ward Community Reference and Sporting Group Dr Chris Howard said giving people alternative options was very important.

"We all want less traffic congestion and healthier, more active lifestyles. These paths give people a genuine choice to leave their cars at home and ride to the local shops, schools or train station," he said.

The \$352,000 Ocean Reef Road project will be a 1160m shared path on the south side, from Hartman Drive to the City boundary and to Trappers Drive.

This path will improve cyclist connections between Edgewater Train Station and Wangara Industrial Area.

BUDGET BOOSTS PLAY TIME IN THE CITY

LANDSDALE FAMILIES WILL SOON HAVE ACCESS TO AN EXCITING NEW \$59,000 PLAY SPACE AT SANDISON PARK THANKS TO THIS YEAR'S CITY OF WANNEROO BUDGET.

The new play equipment is part of the City's program to provide more facilities at developed parks and reserves to keep children active.

City of Wanneroo Mayor Tracey Roberts said it was important to consider the needs of all residents, including our youngest, when developing the budget.

"The City is committed to providing opportunities for the growing number of young families to enjoy the outdoors within a safe environment."

Landsdale mother and family day care owner Rachel Houareau said keeping kids active was key in today's society.

"Children learn through play and by keeping them physically fit the body and brain can be healthy," she said.

"The outdoors provides freedom and open opportunities for learning and imagination and this park will be a wonderful addition to the area."

New playground shade sails will also be installed in coming months at San Teodoro Park in Sinagra and Blackmore Park in Girrawheen.

"Sunshades are very important because we live in a place that can have high UV and we need to protect against sun damage," Rachel said.

"Park equipment slides and swings get very hot and can't be used in the heat of the day if not provided with sun shades."

The sails also protect the play equipment from deterioration which extends the lifespan and saves on replacement costs.

Each year, the City's Parks Shade Sail Project provides shade to three existing play areas with \$75,000 dedicated in this year's budget.
