Parking at schools has long been an issue, and with the added hazard of hundreds of children in the vicinity, it is important for everyone to be alert and aware of the dangers, according to Mayor Tracey Roberts.

"Dropping children off and picking them up from school can be stressful as it is a very busy time on roads and it is the responsibility of drivers to park their car legally and help ease parking issues," Mayor Roberts said. "The main concerns are speeding motorists, parking on footpaths, across driveways and on median strips, as well as disregarding parking signs."

Motorists need to adhere to the 40km/h speed limit set for school zones, and take note of any prohibition signs around schools.


