Quinns Mindarie Community Centre

Work has now started on the Quinns Mindarie Community Centre, with construction expected to be completed in July 2017.

The \$4million project involves the construction of a second storey extension to the existing surf life saving club, which will allow for a multi-purpose facility with function hall, kitchen, meeting and training rooms and playground facilities for the benefit of the northern coastal residents.

Broad Construction Services are working on the community centre only, and there are not currently any works taking place at the nearby caravan park site. The City is working closely with the Quinns Mindarie Surf Life Saving Club to ensure minimal disruption to the season.

Cockman House works to preserve Wanneroo's history



Cockman House provides a unique insight into pioneering times in Wanneroo.

One of the City of Wanneroo's most important heritage buildings is temporarily closed for maintenance. Remedial works are taking place in the closure between 19 September and 29 October, ensuring future generations can continue to learn about the importance of the Cockman family and Wanneroo's pioneering history.

"Cockman House was built more than 150 years ago and visitors enjoy a glimpse into the past," Mayor Tracey Roberts said.

"Cockman House, holds a sentimental and special place in Wanneroo's rich history as the home of one of the earliest settler families. It was built by James Cockman and finished in 1860," she said.

Cockman House is listed on the State Heritage Register and has operated as a museum since 1989, providing a unique opportunity for teachers and students to experience what life was like in our pioneering times.

Weed control notice

Broadleaf weed control is currently taking place in turf areas across all parks. Turf-registered selective herbicides will be applied for control of broadleaf and clover type weeds until 30 September 2016.

Hardstand and kerb line weed control is also underway. Non-selective herbicides will be applied for the post emergent control of annual weeds until 31 October 2016.

All applications will be made according to the specific product label by licensed contractors in accordance with Health Department of WA regulations.
