
Families can also indulge in a range of delicious offerings from Perth's best mobile food trucks or pack a picnic and enjoy quality entertainment under the stars.

Road improvements continuing in the northern suburbs

Major road improvements are continuing in the northern suburbs, with construction on the Connolly Drive duplication and Mitchell Freeway extension.

To facilitate the upgrade of Hester Avenue as part of the Mitchell Freeway Extension: Burns Beach Road to Hester Avenue project, the intersection of Hester Avenue/Hidden

Valley Retreat will be closed from 10 September to late October 2016, weather permitting.

A detour will be in place at Walyunga Boulevard / Porongorup Drive.

When the intersection re-opens, the right turn from Hidden Valley Retreat to Hester Avenue (eastbound) will be permanently closed for the safety of road users.

In its final format, access to Hester Avenue (eastbound) will be available via the new roundabout at Ridgewood Boulevard.

Connolly Drive will see an additional lane constructed in each direction from Lukin Drive to Neerabup Road.

The project started last April and will be completed in November 2016 with some stages open prior to then.

Weed control notice

Broadleaf weed control is currently taking place in turf areas across all parks. Turf-registered selective herbicides will be applied for control of broadleaf and clover type weeds until 30 September 2016.

Hardstand and kerb line weed control is also underway. Non-selective herbicides will be applied for the post emergent control of annual weeds until 31 October 2016.

All applications will be made according to the specific product label by licensed contractors in accordance with Health Department of WA regulations.
