Connect Wanneroo

One of the things I am most proud of is our vibrant and rapidly growing community.

Such growth brings many challenges, but the Council is working hard to make sure our beautiful City remains a place in which we love to live, work and play.

A key part of this is creating local jobs for local people. The City covers 684km², therefore local jobs close to home are incredibly important for members of our community.

Equally, for those who do commute, journeys should be simpler and much shorter. Our City's families deserve to spend precious time together and less time stuck on congested roads.

These improvements will only be made possible if state and federal

governments make strong financial commitments to vital transport infrastructure for our City.

'Connect Wanneroo' is a community campaign, strongly supported by the City of Wanneroo, demanding that the state government commits to funding rail to Yanchep, and immediately extend the Mitchell Freeway to Romeo Road in Alkimos.

The City needs your help to make sure politicians hear our collective voices as we head towards the State Election on 11 March. With enough people telling them the same thing, they will not be able to ignore us.

To get on board and play your part in making the City a better place for you and your family, I urge you to sign up and tell our politicians that you want rail to Yanchep, and the freeway immediately extended to Romeo Road.

Firebreak Notice

FIREBREAKS MUST BE CLEARED BY TUESDAY 15 NOVEMBER 2016 AND KEPT CLEAR UNTIL SUNDAY 30 APRIL 2017.

Less than 2000sqm - a firebreak no less than 2m wide by 2m high is required around the perimeter and the growth on the firebreak cannot exceed 20mm high.

Greater than 2000sqm - a firebreak no less than 3 metres wide by 3 metres high is required around the perimeter and the growth on the firebreak cannot exceed 20mm high

Burning permits are required all year round. All burning is prohibited from 1 December until the 31 March each year.

This is a requirement under the Bush Fires Act Section 33.

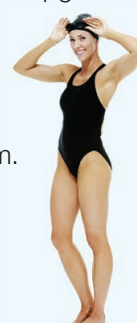

Registrations and renewals are due 1 Nov

PETS

All dogs (over the age of 3 months) and cats (over the age of 6 months) must be registered.

Dogs must wear both a registration tag and disc showing the owner's name and address.

For cat and new dog registrations the microchip number must be supplied for to enable processing.
