#### **Swimming Enclosure**

I was pleased to officially launch the highly anticipated new swimming enclosure at Quinns Beach on 31 January and many beach users are putting the 85 x 300 metre enclosure to good use knowing they are safe from large marine predators.

The state government contributed \$200,000 while the City contributed \$250,000 to the project, which is one of a number of improvement projects in the Quinns Beach precinct.
