Kingsway Dog Exercise Area

The City of Wanneroo is home to more than 27,000 registered dogs and I am delighted to announce that the City's first ever dedicated dog exercise area is now open to the public.

Residents and their four-legged friends can enjoy the freedom of the off-leash area within the Kingsway Sporting Complex in Madeley, which is a welcome addition to this highly valued community space.

The 5000sqm park is located adjacent to the baseball diamonds, and features a large fenced-in grass area and limestone block seating.

Future plans for the park include agility equipment, a sand play area, a dog-friendly drink fountain and a small-dog exercise area subject to funding approval.

Intersection Innovation

The upgraded Hester Avenue/Connolly Drive intersection is one of the first in Western Australia to have three lanes leading up to and through a roundabout at one approach.

The three lane roundabout is expected to help ease congestion in the area, as increased traffic is anticipated following the completion of the Mitchell Freeway extension to Hester Avenue.

Onsite signage has been installed to guide users through the intersection, and the City's website has a short

The City of Wanneroo will be the only local government in Western Australia to welcome the Queen's Baton Relay in two suburbs ahead of the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games.

Mayor Tracey Roberts said she was very proud that both Quinns Rocks and Wanneroo were selected for the Queen's Baton Relay.

"It is significant that two communities

within the City have an opportunity to be showcased on the international stage, and I know local residents will celebrate this momentous occasion with enthusiasm," Mayor Roberts said.

"Our City is the largest growing local government in the state, and to be included in the worldwide journey of the Queen's Baton Relay is an incredible honour.

"Seventy nations will be competing in the Commonwealth Games and the City of Wanneroo will wholeheartedly embrace their part in such a special event.

"Relay activities and our public celebrations will be announced later this year and we will keep the community informed of the details."
