

Free immunisation available for residents

Did you know the City of Wanneroo offers a free immunisation service?

Many potentially life threatening childhood diseases are preventable.

Wanneroo Mayor Tracey Roberts said the City was supporting residents to access this vital service.

"The City of Wanneroo's Health Services team provides a free service for infants and children in accordance with the Western Australian Vaccination Schedule," Mayor Tracey Roberts said.

"A certified immunisation nurse administers all of the vaccines and experienced staff are available to give advice."

Immunisation clinics are held monthly at the Jenolan Way Community Centre in Merriwa and fortnightly at the Wanneroo Library and Cultural Centre, Wanneroo.

School based immunisation program for teenagers

The immunisation team will visit all high schools within the City of Wanneroo during the course of the year.

The Western Australian School Based Immunisation Program is offered to all

year 8 students, with the second round of Gardasil (HPV) and varicella zoster (chicken pox) vaccines already taking place.

Students have also been vaccinated for diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis.

The City will offer the Meningococcal W vaccines to year 10, 11 and 12 students during Term 3.

Young people who have left school or are up to 19 years of age can also

Matt's \$50,000 pedal-power ride for Telethon

Earlier this month, Two Rocks resident and father, Matt Campbell, completed a 2,100km ride from Broome to Two Rocks, raising almost \$50,000 for Telethon.

Matt began his journey in Broome on 12 June and pedalled up to 123km a day to complete the ride in just 22 days, arriving in Two Rocks to plenty of fanfare on 3 July.

An amazing achievement by any standard, but what makes Matt's achievement that much more amazing is that the 35-year-old is a multiple stroke survivor.

Matt experienced his first stroke at the age of five. As Matt's mum, Debbie Hartley, recalls, "My son, Matthew! Typical five year old boy, cheeky,

naughty, adventurous and a wicked sense of humour!

"He was sent to his bedroom for being naughty one afternoon, and when he woke up from his nap, life from that moment changed.

"Matthew kept falling; I asked him what was wrong. He said he 'felt funny'. I got a dart and pricked his hands and feet and he had no feeling on the right side. I quickly took him to Fremantle Hospital.

"After the doctors checked Matt over, they told me he had suffered a stroke. I was gobsmacked!

Matt was sent to Princess Margaret Hospital and hospitalised for three weeks. Test after test, they could not find out why Matt had a stroke".

Six months later on the morning of 11 January, 1988 Matt had another stroke. The prognosis from doctors this time was that he would never walk again.

Matt has defied the odds and wants to raise as much money as he can for Telethon this year in recognition of the important part the organisation played in his recovery.
