

Yanchep National Park – Annual Park Pass Program

Terms & Conditions

The Program

- Annual park passes are sold directly by the State Government through the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) and not by the City of Wanneroo (City).
- The Annual Park Pass Program (Program) is for Yanchep National Park only and does not include any other park.
- In collaboration with DBCA, the City has negotiated a discount on annual park passes for City of Wanneroo residents and/or ratepayers.
- The online website through which annual park passes are sold is managed by DBCA. Upon completion of purchase, an electronic pass will be issued and the pass holder is required to print this and display it on the vehicle dashboard of any eligible vehicles.
- There are a limited number of park passes available under this Program and once these are exhausted no further passes will be available for sale at the discounted price.
- The City reserves its rights to cancel the Program at any time.

Eligibility

- Only City of Wanneroo residents and/or ratepayers who are 18 years of age or older are eligible to purchase discounted Annual Park Passes under the Program.
- DBCA and Yanchep National Park reserve the right to seek proof of eligibility for an Annual Park Pass, by requesting applicants to show one of the following:
 - Rates Notice issued by the City of Wanneroo;
 - Driver's Licence showing a City of Wanneroo address;
 - Utility Bill showing a City of Wanneroo address.
- There is a limit of one discounted pass per household.
- The City reserves the right to cancel an individual pass at any time if it deems the applicant to be ineligible for participation in the Program.
- City of Wanneroo employees are eligible to participate in the Program if they meet the above eligibility requirements.

The Cost

- The discounted Annual Park Pass for City of Wanneroo residents and/or ratepayers under the Program is \$18.
The normal cost of the Annual Park Pass is \$30.

The Rules

- Normal Annual Park Pass rules apply, including:
 - The pass is valid only for Yanchep National Park.
 - Valid for one vehicle with up to 12 legally seated people.

- Applicants are entitled to nominate 2 cars per Annual Park Pass, but they should be registered at the same address. The pass can only admit one vehicle at any one time/day.
 - Passes are for individuals for private use and are not transferable.
- Applicants can choose to nominate the start date for the Annual Pass, via the DBCA website. Passes are valid for 12 months from this date.
- When purchasing an Annual Park Pass, applicants will be asked if they agree to participate in ongoing feedback and surveys in connection with the Program.
