

Helpful Information

• We recommend ALL participants wear goggles to swim lessons.



• Parents participating in AquaBaby and Toddler classes are strongly encouraged to wear a t-shirt in lessons for their child to grasp onto and pull up – a safety skill that could save your child’s life.

• All children that normally wear a nappy are required to wear some form of aqua nappy if swimming in a public facility. We encourage children to be changed into their aqua nappy “on site”, using the change tables provided on pool deck or in our family changerooms.

• **All AquaBaby, Toddler and most Preschool classes are held in the Hydrotherapy Pool. This pool is located to the right of the main entry and both the water and air in this area are heated.**

Spectators may find the heated air uncomfortable and are encouraged to take breaks from the area and drink water frequently. Mothers who participate in swim classes who are pregnant are advised to inform their Swim Instructor.

• EVERY activity, song or rhyme in our lessons are skill based and follow a series of progressions for your child to learn a range of water safety and swimming skills.

• **Our lessons focus on water safety, aquatic readiness, stroke development and FUN!**

• **Children under 5 years of age** must be actively supervised by a responsible person over 16 years of age who is in the water with the child(ren) at all times. Adequate supervision requires the parent/guardian to accompany the child in the water and remain within arms reach of the child at all times.

• **Children under 10 years of age** must be constantly supervised by a responsible person over 16 years of age who is positioned to have a clear view of the child/children, with no physical or structural barriers between them while in the centre.

• **For Children 10 Years & Older** parents must use their knowledge of the child’s swimming ability to determine the level of accompaniment required.

Please note:

Parents of children under 10 years of age may not leave the Centre during their child’s swimming lesson. Children not appropriately supervised will be removed from the water and placed in a safe area until collected by the parent / guardian.

A staff member will remove an unsupervised child of poor swimming ability from the water regardless of age if the staff member is concerned for their safety.

TODDLER & PRESCHOOL SWIM CLASSES:

"What level do I enrol my child into?"

If your child is 2½ to 3 years old (Toddler) or 3 to 5 years old (Preschooler) please discuss your child's needs and swimming ability with a Swim School Coordinator by phoning 9405 5999.

SCHOOL AGE CLASSES:

"What level do I enrol my child into?"

In order to ensure that swimmers are enrolled in the appropriate class level, we will need to "sight" a swimming certificate from our own program that is **less than 6 months old. If no appropriate certificate is available, you will need to book your child in for a free swim assessment.** We do not accept certificates from Department of Education/school swimming lessons. Please call Customer Service on 9405 5999 to book an assessment.

DOLPHIN CLASSES:

The Dolphin Program caters for children with special needs and classes are available in both our Heated Program Pool and our heated Lap and Leisure Pools. Please speak with Robyn Grealy on 9405 5991.

"HOW DO I ENROL?"

Swim School Enrolments can be done in person during Centre opening hours. Should you wish to speak with a Swim School Coordinator, please phone during Swim School office hours.

PHONE ENROLMENTS

If you are unable to attend in person to enrol, you may phone during the above Swim School office hours and we will attempt to take your enrolment. However, please be aware that priority will be given to those who attend in person so if all staff are busy your details will be taken and one of the Swim School Coordinators will return your call as soon as possible. Phone enrolments must be paid by Credit Card at the time of enrolment.

Payment can be made by cash, cheque, EFTPOS or Credit Card (Mastercard and Visa only). Please note we do not accept Diners or American Express. Please note that all Credit Card payments made to the City of Wanneroo incur a surcharge of 0.57%. This includes GST.

WHAT DOES THE TERM FEE INCLUDE?

Your term lesson fees include Pool Entry for the swimmer, lesson for the swimmer, Spectator entry. A Carer/Parent's Pool Entry is included if they are required to participate in their child's lesson.

Upon enrolment, one Swim School Spectator and one Swim School Student membership card will be issued. Please note that your membership card is ongoing and there will be a \$7.00 fee if a replacement card is required.

When you attend for your lesson, please ensure your entry cards for the swimmer and Spectator are swiped at the entry gates. Even if your lesson is conducted in the Hydrotherapy Pool, please swipe your cards at the entry gates and then proceed to the Hydrotherapy suite.
